

Introducing: Retrofit Lighting

During the time our sanctuary will be repainted a process of retrofitting our lighting will also be ongoing. What is retrofit lighting? A lighting retrofit is a simple way to make our lighting more energy efficient. Lighting retrofits not only improve the quality of light, but also result in less heat in the building. Church Interiors will provide all labor, material and expenses to retrofit our eight traditional pendant fixtures in the sanctuary and three smaller fixtures in the entrance areas. We recognize (Church Interiors does too!) that our light fixtures are very old and very special to us. Our fixtures will be removed, carefully packed and transported to a special plant in Lynchburg, VA. There they will be retrofitted (at the Lynchburg plant) and brought back to us to be reinstalled. Over the course of time we expect Christ Moravian Church will see a difference in our monthly energy bill. This along with the fact these bulbs have a lifespan of over 50,000+ hours (reducing maintenance costs and safety issues for changing current bulbs) help us create a more energy efficient environment for worship.
