**Psalm 32:1-7 (NRSV)**

*The Joy of Forgiveness*

<sup>1</sup> Happy are those whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.  
<sup>2</sup> Happy are those to whom the Lord imputes no iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit.  
<sup>3</sup> While I kept silence, my body wasted away through my groaning all day long.  
<sup>4</sup> For day and night your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was dried up<sup>[a]</sup> as by the heat of summer. *Selah*  
<sup>5</sup> Then I acknowledged my sin to you, and I did not hide my iniquity; I said, 'I will confess my transgressions to the Lord', and you forgave the guilt of my sin. *Selah*

**Luke 19:1-10 (NRSV)**

<sup>19</sup> He entered Jericho and was passing through it. <sup>2</sup> A man was there named Zacchaeus; he was a chief tax-collector and was rich. <sup>3</sup> He was trying to see who Jesus was, but on account of the crowd he could not, because he was short in stature. <sup>4</sup> So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore tree to see him, because he was going to pass that way. <sup>5</sup> When Jesus came to the place, he looked up and said to him, 'Zacchaeus, hurry and come down; for I must stay at your house today.' <sup>6</sup> So he hurried down and was happy to welcome him. <sup>7</sup> All who saw it began to grumble and said, 'He has gone to be the guest of one who is a sinner.' <sup>8</sup> Zacchaeus stood there and said to the Lord, 'Look, half of my possessions, Lord, I will give to the poor; and if I have defrauded anyone of anything, I will pay back four times as much.' <sup>9</sup> Then Jesus said to him, 'Today salvation has come to this house, because he too is a son of Abraham. <sup>10</sup> For the Son of Man came to seek out and to save the lost.'
